Gospel - John 15: 17-27


¹⁷I am giving you these commands so that you may love one another. ¹⁸ "If the world hates you, be aware that it hated me before it hated you. ¹⁹ If you belonged to the world, the world would love you as its own. Because you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world—therefore the world hates you. ²⁰ Remember the word that I said to you, 'Servants are not greater than their master.' If they persecuted me, they will persecute you; if they kept my word, they will keep yours also. ²¹ But they will do all these things to you on account of my name, because they do not know him who sent me. ²² If I had not come and spoken to them, they

would not have sin; but now they have no excuse for their sin.

²³ Whoever hates me hates my
Father also. ²⁴ If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not have sin.

But now they have seen and hated both me and my Father. ²⁵ It was to fulfil the word that is written in their law, 'They hated me without a cause.'

²⁶ "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf. ²⁷ You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning.
