As I watched, thrones were set in place, and an Ancient One took his throne. his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames. and its wheels were burning fire. ¹⁰ A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence. ⁷Look! He is coming with the clouds; every eye will see him, even those who pierced him; and on his account all the tribes of the earth will wail.


