Revelation 11: 19-12.6,10 - Sarah

Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple, and there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail. 12 A great portent appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.² She was pregnant and was crying out in birth pangs, in the agony of giving birth. ³Then another portent appeared in heaven: a great red dragon, with seven heads and ten horns and seven diadems on his heads. ⁴ His tail swept down a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. Then the dragon stood before the woman who was about to deliver a child, so that he might devour her child as soon as it was born. ⁵ And she gave birth to a son, a male child, who is to rule all the nations with a sceptre of iron. But her child was snatched away and taken to God and to his throne, ⁶ and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, so that there she can be nourished for one thousand two hundred sixty days. ¹⁰ Then I heard a loud voice in heaven proclaiming, "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Messiah, for the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God.

¹⁰ Kings' daughters were among thy honourable women: upon thy right hand did stand the queen in a vesture of gold, wrought about with divers colours. ¹¹ Hearken, O daughter, and consider, incline thine ear: forget also thine own people, and thy father's house. ¹² So shall the King have pleasure in thy beauty: for he is thy Lord God, and worship thou him. ¹³ And the daughter of Tyre shall be there with a gift: like as the rich also among the people shall make their supplication before thee. ¹⁴ The King's daughter is all glorious within: her clothing is of wrought gold. ¹⁵ She shall be brought unto the King in raiment of needle-work: the virgins that be her fellows shall bear her company, and shall be brought unto thee. ¹⁶ With joy and gladness shall they be brought: and shall enter into the King's palace.
